For Students Who are Not Identified as a High Risk Contact

All St. Peter's students who have not been directly exposed to COVID-19 cases in the school are asked to monitor their health and should only leave the home for essential purposes.

For Parents & Guardians,

Look for and ask your child about any symptoms. Here are a list of COVID-19 symptoms to look for: https://covid-19.ontario.ca/self-assessment/

If Your Child Develops Symptoms Consistent with COVID-19:

- **1.** Your child should <u>isolate</u> (stay home) away from household members and not leave except to get tested or for a medical emergency
- **2.** Talk with a doctor/health care provider to get advice or an assessment, including if your child needs a COVID-19 test immediately
- **3.** Siblings or other people you live with need to -stay home until your child tests negative, or is diagnosed with another illness-
- **4.** Your child must be able to pass the COVID-19 Self-Assessment Tool before returning to school.
 - To return to school, your child must also not have a fever (without using medication), and it has been at least 24 hours since their symptoms started improving-

If your child develops symptoms and does not get tested:

- They must isolate for 10 days-
- All household members will also need to isolate and stay isolated for 14 days from last contact with the child with symptoms.

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If Your Child Does Not Develop Symptoms:

Testing is available at the Assessment Centre, if you choose to have your child tested, it is recommended your child get a COVID-19 test done March 2nd (day 7) or later (7 days or more* after exposure) (please keep in mind your child needs to have received a negative test result IF TESTED to return to school on March 11th and may not return with a pending result)
