

CELL PHONE USAGE AT SCHOOL

Student phone usage at school is limited to the classroom when permitted by the teacher. Phones are not permitted on the playground or in the school.

If a student needs to contact a parent, they are to do so through the office. Students SHOULD NOT be contacting parents or grandparents directly for permission to go out for lunch or to come and pick them up. By calling parents through the office, the school knows when students are ill and if a

parent is coming to pick them up. This is for safety and legal purposes

ATTENDANCE AND SCHOOL MESSENGER

If you know your child is going to be absent or late for school, please call the office at 519-752-1611 **BEFORE** 8:35 am with the reason for their absence. There is 24/7 voicemail available.

If a call is not received your child is marked "Unconfirmed Absence". School Messenger then sends out the automatic message for you to call the school to report your child's absence. If we do not have contact from you prior to the afternoon attendance you will receive another notification from School Messenger.

A report is sent to the school from the School Messenger program indicating whether or not the call was answered or if the email was opened.



STOPPING/PARKING ON GLENWOOD - IN FRONT OF SCHOOL

Parents, grandparents, babysitters and all others are reminded that there are designated NO PARKING areas on Glenwood Avenue.
